### TAMPER PROOF YOUR CONTROL PANELS

Fountain controls and electrical components are housed in factory panels mounted on shore. Switches are often placed on the outside for easy access, which can be inviting for curious minds and hands. Upon request, we will relocate external controls to the interior and secure the panels with high quality locks. Security, peace of mind and elimination of service calls from fiddling hands for a minimal upgrade fee.



### PREDICTABLE AND BUDGETABLE PARTS AND LABOR
